Declaration of consent

I hereby give my consent to Aarhus Airport A/S passing on this declaration of consent to the police. The police shall obtain information about me from the CPR-register (confirmation of identity) and the police registers, including, if relevant, from foreign police registers, to be used in the assessment of whether an access permit should be issued to me for the airside area and/or security protected area, cf. section 4 of Order no. 979 of 2004. The police shall search the police registers for information on any criminal offenses, cf. annex 2 to the Order. I accept that an ID card/access permit to Aarhus Airport is strictly personal and may only be used for official business purposes and that this declaration of consent will be in force as long as I am employed with the above company

The Danish Aviation Act § 70, 2. pkt.:

"The Minister of Transport shall have the power to make directions to the effect that access permits to the airside area of the airport may only be issued to persons approved by the police"

Appendix to Regulation (EC) No. 300/2008 Sec. 1.2.4, see Commission Regulation 185/2010 sec. 1.2.3.1

"Persons, including flight crew members, must have successfully completed a background check before either a crew identification card or an airport identification card authorising unescorted access to security restricted areas is issued to them."

"A crew identification card for a crew member employed by a Union air carrier and an airport identification card may only be issued to a person who has an operational need and has successfully completed a background check in accordance with point 11.1.3."

Excerpt from § 4 of the declaration:

Paragraph 1 "General access permits (airport ID-cards) to the airside area of the airport shall be issued only to persons approved by the police".

Paragraph. 2: "Access permits for more than one day to the security restricted area of the airport shall be issued only to persons approved by the police"

Paragraph. 4: "Irrespective of the rules on issuance of access permits in the model security plan for airports, one-day access permits may be issued to an unlimited extent to representatives of the press, if such representatives have been approved by the police in accordance with the provisions of this Order. Such approval shall apply for terms of three years"
